



### **Liberal Party of Canada receives highest score in electoral audit**

The Liberal Party of Canada received the highest overall score of 61.54 per cent in an electoral audit conducted by the Calgary-based [Foundation for Democratic Advancement \(FDA\)](#). Areas of analysis included background of party leaders, vision for Canada, incumbency record of the Conservative Party of Canada, and the following policy areas: economy, taxes, energy, environment, education, health, domestic security, foreign policy, democracy reform, and miscellaneous policies.

Key points for the Liberal Party of Canada gleaned from the [study](#):

- The Liberal Party of Canada has the highest scores for the economy, taxes, and education policy sections at 80% in each section.
- The FDA recommends that the Liberal Party of Canada should form a minority government or a coalition government.
